- 11:00 AM Babe's BBQ, our caterer for this event, will begin serving lunch. The lunch will include: pulled pork, beans, potato salad, and other selections.
- Noon Alumni friends are invited to migrate towards the Recreation Activity Center (RAC), where several alumni have a reserved spot in the RAC parking lot for tailgating – this is a private event and not an official ΣN event, but you are welcome to join them.

 Others may remain at the tailgate as I understand it remains open all day.
