The years 2017-2020 – our 50th Anniversary Celebration: This year we begin the start of our 50th Anniversary Celebration. On Friday, November 17, 1967 a group of men, led by Robert Williams, met in Dorman Hall to decide to form a fraternity. The following Spring on Monday, May 6, 1968, we were colonized in Sigma Nu and on Sunday, May 10, 1970, we were chartered as the Theta Kappa Chapter (#171) of Sigma Nu Fraternity.

This is our **5th Annual Commanders' Dinner**, which we hold upon the election of the newest Eminent Commander at Theta Kappa. The purpose is to welcome the new commander, convey the wisdom of our collective experience, our passion for leadership, our willingness to support and mentor him, the need to protect the brand and name of Theta Kappa and Sigma Nu, and the need to always make the right yet sometimes very hard and unpopular decisions for the good of the chapter and fraternity.

On Saturday, January 14, 2017, we honored and welcomed our 47th Commander of the Theta Kappa, **Marshall B. Richards (ΘK 847)**, to his new role. Marshall is from Canton GA, where he attended Creekview High School, is a Finance Major and a Junior at Georgia Southern. He was sworn in (again) by past Commander Zach Geurin (ΘK 823) and presented an engraved gavel & block on behalf of the Theta Kappa Alumni. Congratulations and best wishes to Marshall, his leadership team, and the entire Chapter as they move forward in 2017.

As part of this tradition, the Commander gives a **"State of the Chapter" presentation to those in attendance** and takes questions from the floor. It was a great update, well received by all, and was highlighted by presence of recognition and awards the chapter has received in the last 3 years, including the prestigious **Rock Chapter Award of Sigma Nu Fraternity**. We initiated a new tradition this year presenting the outgoing **Commander with a Sigma Nu Commander's Badge** engraved with their initials, initiate number, and term, so Zach Geurin was the first to receive it and was pinned on by Marshall.

In recognition of the leadership and effort that has been required over the last several years, we chose to present each **Past Commander** since 2013 **with a Commander's Badge** similarly engraved, so we presented those to:

- **Zach A. Geurin (ΘK 823, 46th)**

Thank you to each of these young **ΣN** leaders and wear your new **Commander's Badge** with pride and the deep appreciation of your chapter.

History, traditions, and heroes – our Sigma Nu brotherhood! As we installed and recognized our most recent leaders, we felt it important to recognize our first Commander. At this event, we presented **Robert G. Williams, ΘK 258**, with an engraved **Commander's Badge** for his role in our chapter founding and as **our 1st Commander** (1967-68). The **Commander's Badge** was pinned on by Marshall, as part of our evening program. We were chartered in 1970, but due to service in Vietnam, Robert was unavailable for initiation. It was not until November 15, 1986 that Robert and 13 other alumni were finally initiated; later 2 more were initiated. He has been a very active alumnus since 1986 and it is with great pride **that he finally wears the Commander's Badge.**

In recognition of his service and organizing the **Commanders' Dinner**, we also presented past Commander **John B. Austin (ΘK 120, 11th)**, with a **Commander's Badge**. **Since we started this** in 2013, John has recruited, organized, and facilitated this new Theta Kappa tradition. Each year we have raised the bar on the event, so it is a fitting recognition of his volunteer service.

Sigma Nu "Jacketing Ceremony" – Much like the infamous Green Jacket from the **Master's in Augusta**, Sigma Nu has its own. A Black Blazer emblazoned with the Sigma Nu Coat of Arms – the Sigma Nu Educational Foundation presents this to its most generous donors as they join the **"Knight's Council"**. During the **Commanders' Dinner**, the **Foundation "jacketed"** our own brother **Anthony B. Fair (ΘK 9)**. On hand were Brad Hastings, the Foundation President, and Brother Joe Gilman, Past Chairman of the Foundation and a Past Regent. Tony has been a generous contributor to the Foundation, the Omega Society where he is a founding member, and has bought enough bricks (well over 100) that Theta Kappa has its own section in the Pathway to Honor at the Sigma Nu HQs.

Both Brad and Joe provided remarks, but one comment made is that the Theta Kappa Chapter has more members in the **Omega Society** than any **other ΣN** Chapter. It is especially fitting that we celebrate these various successes as we approach the 50th Anniversary of the Chapter in this the 50th year since our founding in 1967; we will celebrate until 2020 our official 50th.

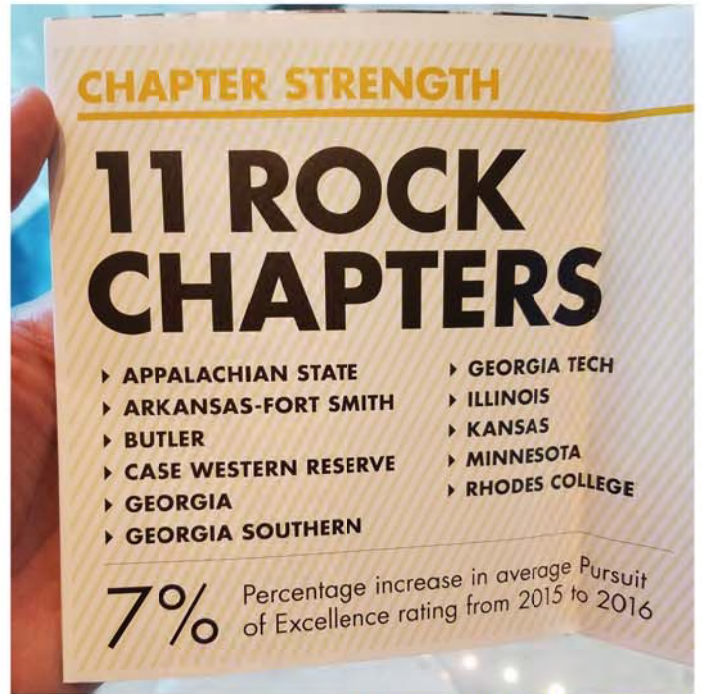


